A NOTE FROM ACS HEAD OF SCHOOL


Hail Knights!

TRIP (TUITION REDUCTION INCENTIVE PROGRAM)

TRIP is a program offered by Great Lakes Scrip Center (GLSC) to nonprofit organizations like ACS.

Gift cards are purchased at face value with the discount passed on in the form of a tuition credit that is applied to the family's tuition account every quarter. TRIP even allows you to start saving towards the future tuition of younger children who aren't ready for school yet.

TRIP can be used toward payment of our Wee Knights daycare program as well! PLUS, with every purchase, a small portion comes back to the school's Tuition Assistance Fund.

Through our TRIP program, our families have saved over \$26,500 in tuition last school year! The Tuition Assistance and Algoma Funds have benefited by almost \$8,000!
